- 1. Consistent with the goal of the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) to provide Professional Development Programs that will upskill and reskill the teachers and school leaders, this Office informs the Schools Division Offices about the First Call of the Scholarship Programs offered by the Southeast Asian Minister of Education, Organization, Innovation, and Technology (SEAMEO INNOTECH) for Calendar Year 2023.
- 2. SEAMEO INNOTECH offers four (4) Flexible Learning Courses (FLCs) titled: Strategic Thinking and Innovation Course 2 (Charting and Innovative School Strategy; Strategic Thinking and Innovation Course 3 (Leading and Sustaining Change); and Early Literacy for K3 Teachers. It also offers two (2) Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) title Teach On: Keeping the Passion Alive and Becoming a Better Teacher Everyday.
- 3. For this First Call, SDO Pampanga will facilitate three (3) FLCs:
 - 3.1 Early Literacy for K3 Teachers
 - 3.2 Teach On: Keeping the Passion Alive
 - 3.3 Becoming a Better Teacher Everyday.
- 4. Course details, target participants, program descriptions, timeline, assessment requirements, certificate, equivalent training hours, and value can be seen in Enclosure 1 (Accredited SEAMEO INNOTECH Course Details), as reference in choosing the best applicants for the courses.
- 5. Districts and clusters are given one (1) slot per FLC. Chosen applicant for each FLC shall register through the link: https://bit.ly/seameo1st2023 on or before **January 19, 2022 until 5:00 PM**. All the names and information encoded until the said deadline will be formally endorsed to the NEAP Regional Office III for endorsement to the SEAMEO INNOTECII as participants for the First Call of the scholarship programs.

- c. submit to the head of office and the Department of Education (DepEd) through the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) a copy of the NEAP-PDP Action Plan containing lessons for the conduct of echo seminars to share new learnings, teaching innovations, and strategies to their co-workers and administrators, various trainings, program highlights and general impressions constituting a general evaluation of the program at the end of the program or course;
- d. implement the echo seminars / LAC Sessions and submit reports to the QUALITY ASSURANCE DIVISION, National Educators Academy of the Philippines at Second Floor, Mabini Building, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City;
- e. teach the subject / conduct echo seminars / LAC Sessions on the course in which they
 participation in continue to serve their school / division / region for at least three years which
 is the service obligation equivalent for a year of scholarship or a fraction thereof;
- f. fulfill the service obligation as required under Sections 17 and 19 Rule VIII of the Omnibus Rules Implementing Book V of Executive Order No. 292;
- g. refund in full to DepEd such sums of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine government for expenses incidental for having attended the program or course, for failure to comply with any of the foregoing conditions through my fault or willful neglect, resignation from the service, transfer to other agencies, voluntary retirement or other causes within my control.
