ADMINISTRATION OF THE NATIONAL LEARNING CAMP ASSESSMENT (NLCA)

To: Asst. Schools Division Superintendents
Chief Education Supervisors
Education Program Supervisors
Public Schools District Supervisors

Others Concerned

1. The Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA), through this division, shall conduct the National Learning Camp Assessment (NLCA), an online computer-based assessment for all Grade 7 and 8 Learners in all the public schools within the following testing window.

Phase	Time Frame	Test-Takers		School Year
Pre-Test	June -July, 2023	Grades 7-8	Same cohort	2022-2023
Pots-Test	August 2023	Grades 8-9		2023-2024

2. The NLCA is designed to determine the effectiveness of the learning camp intervention on the learning proficiencies of participating learners before and after attending the National Learning Camp intervention program. The test shall cover learning areas in English, Science, and Mathematics, wherein test items measure varying levels of skills and competencies in a multiple-choice format using the English language.
3. All Grades 7 and 8 shall take the exam in the schools. With this, the school principal and the ICT Coordinator shall take the necessary preparations of making the computers/laptops and internet connectivity available for use. The NLCA is an online computer-based test that will be delivered through the Moodle platform. For schools that are unable to hold the necessary requirements, an alternative testing centers in strategic locations should be considered.
4. Also, all enrolled Grades 7 and 8 learners from all public schools should activate/access their Moodle LMS accounts using their official DepEd Microsoft accounts for the conduct of the NLC Assessment. School Testing and Division ITO should ensure that the learners have access to their DepEd Microsoft account and have accessed the DepEd LMS platform before the test administration.

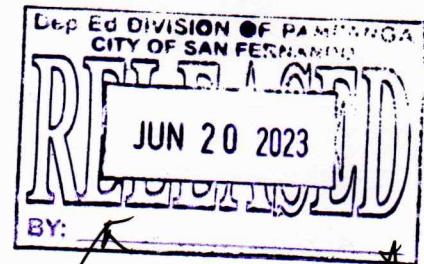
