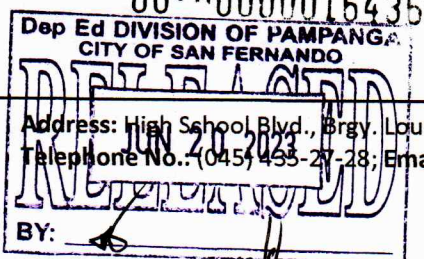
SOLIDARITY MEETING OF DIVISION TECHNOLYMPICS WINNERS
