DRRM MID-YEAR CONSULTATION, EVALUATION, AND PLANNING MEETING

TO: Assistant Schools Division Superintendents
District and Cluster DRRM Coordinators
All Others Concerned

- 1. The importance that DRRM and CCAM played in keeping learners and other school personnel from emerging and re-emerging infectious diseases (EREID), and from perennial natural and human-induced hazards in sustaining School Year 2022-2023 is undeniable.
- 2. As School Year 2023-2024 is about to commence, it is appropriate to systematically investigate how past DRRM and CCAM prevention and mitigation, preparedness, response, and rehabilitation and recovery interventions contributed to this.
- 3. Pursuant to the implementation of SDO-approved project titled "Implementation of DRRM and CCAM Programs, Projects, and Activities", a meeting designed towards this end to be participated in by District and Cluster DRRM Coordinators shall be held on 28 July 2023, from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, at a venue to be announced.
- 4. This meeting shall attempt to draw lessons from the past DRRM and CCAM programs, projects, and activities that can be applied in the implementation of similar programs, projects, and activities this School Year 2023-2024.
- 5. Specifically, the following shall be evaluated and analyzed during the meeting:
 - a. The conduct of first and second quarter NSEDs and the bi-monthly unannounced earthquake and fire drills.
 - b. The implementation of blended learning modality/ies as adaptation measure/s to extreme heat.
 - c. The RADaR App reporting of Magnitude 6.3 Batangas earthquake and other recent hazards.
 - d. The formulation and/or updating of school contingency and DRRM-CCAM plans.
 - e. The general direction and thrust of school plans for SY 2023-2024.
