



1st Speaker:

With fondness, we remember the lady born on September 20, 1898, the beloved late founder of the Girl Scouts of the Philippines, **Josefa Llanes Escoda**.

She was the eldest in a family of seven born to Gabriel Llanes and Mercedes Madamba. She assumed a parental role when her father died in her early childhood thus building the foundation of dynamic leadership.

A consistent scholar, she earned a teacher's certificate, an MA in Sociology and graduate credits in Social Work. She was a notable student, speaker and lecturer as well as leader of Filipinos and Orientals abroad.

Her career and social services included the American Red Cross, Leonard Wood Memorial, the Bureau of Health, National Federation of Woman Clubs, and the Girl Scouts of the Philippines. She had Girl Scouting training in London, USA before she organized the Gril Scouting Movement in the Philippines in 1940.

2nd Speaker:

Flowers we offer and lighted candles Thanking God for our founder Josefa Llanes Escoda GSP's mother

3rd Speaker:

Josefa Llanes Escoda is our model
For loving our fellowmen
Not with words not tongue
But with truth and action
Serving others for a cause
Until her life was lost in the historic recesses of Fort Santiago.

Her perilous but successful attempts to help concentration camp prisoners and some intelligence work earned her the AFP Legionnaire of Honor. For their efforts, Mrs. Escdoa and her husband, Antonio Escoda were captured and incarcerated for espionage in 1945 and never seen again. She was 46 years old.

President Carlos P. Garcia declared September 20 as Josefa Llanes Day in 1959.

4th Speaker:

There is love that stirs the heart and loves that gives rest

But the love that leads life upwards is the noblest and the best

Her last words to remember "Take care of the girls".

Her legacy to love and serve others makes her life forever in the movement she mothered.

Mother to millions of Twinklers, Star, Juniors, Seniors, and Cadets Strong and healthy, caring and wise, dedicated to a mission of service And citizenship at its best
