#### GUIDELINES FOR THE SUBMISSION OF SCHOOL CONTINGENCY PLAN

- To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendents Division Chiefs Functional Unit Heads Education Program Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned
  - 1. Republic Act (RA) 10121 otherwise known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, mandated all government agencies to institutionalize policies, structures, coordination mechanisms and programs with continuing budget appropriation on disaster risk reduction and management (DRRM) from national to local levels, Moreover, RA 9155 or the Government of Basic Education Act of 2001 vested the Department of Education (DepEd) with authority, accountability and responsibility to ensure access to basic education which is often disrupted by emergencies and disasters. This Office, through the School Governance & Operations Division (SGOD)-DRRM Unit facilitates the submission of School Contingency Plans.
  - 2. The deadline of submission of school contingency plans is on December 29, 2023.
  - 3. Below are the guidelines for the submission of school contingency plans:
    - A. The cluster or district DRRM coordinators shall collect the school contingency plans;
    - B. The cluster or district DRRM coordinators shall create a google drive folder and upload all the school contingency plans, then the google drive folder's link shall be shared to <u>paula.meneses@deped.gov.ph</u>. (File name per school contingency plan is the school name) (Google drive folder's name: District or Cluster name\_CP2023);
    - C. In the same google drive folder, upload the summary of school contingency plans per district or cluster in pdf format with the following details:

#### RESOLUTION NO. 02-S-2023

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE UPDATED CONTINGENCY PLAN FOR HYDROMETEOROLOGICAL HAZARDS WITH EREID INTEGRATION, UPDATED CONTINGENCY PLAN FOR EARTHQUAKES WITH EREID INTEGRATION, AND UPDATED CONTINGENCY PLAN FOR VOLCANIC ERUPTION AND HAZARDS WITH EREID INTEGRATION OF THE PROVINCE OF PAMPANGA, RESPECTIVELY, AND RECOMMENDING THE SAME FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN

WHEREAS, the Contingency Plan for Hydrometeorological Hazards and the Contingency Plan for Earthquakes of the province were approved by the Pampanga Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (PDRRMC) last CY 2020 to incorporate public health emergency measures in light of the health hazards that may be posed by the COVID-19 pandemic during worst-case scenarios;

WHEREAS, the revised plans were subsequently adopted by the Sangguniang Lalawigan of the Province by virtue of Sangguniang Panlalawigan Resolution no. 6514;

WHEREAS, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued new guidelines in the comprehensive integration of Emerging and Re-emerging Infectious Diseases (EREID) through a guidebook entitled "EREID Protocols into LGU Contingency Plans\*, which was also approved by the Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council through Resolution No. 02 s. 2023;

WHEREAS, the PDRRMC deemed it necessary to update its existing Contingency Plans for Hydrometeorological Hazards and for Earthquake, respectively, in order to effectively incorporate EREID Concerns by following the above mentioned guidebook issued by the DILG.

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion which was seconded, be it;

RESOLVED AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED to approve the Updated Contingency Plan for Hydrometeorological Hazards with EREID Integration, Updated Contingency Plan for Earthquakes with EREID Integration, and Updated Contingency Plan for Volcanic Eruption and Hazards with EREID Integration of the Province of Pampanga, respectively, and recommending the same for the adoption of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.




Contingency Planning Training Course


