Sa gitna ng pagkalat ng virus, pinag-utos ni Boss Tsip ang isang pangmalawakang lockdown upang mapigilan din ang pagtuligsa at napipintong rebelyon na sinimulan ni Ding (halaw kay Diego Silang), isang uring manggagawa. At sa pagpatay kay Ding, pinagpatuloy ng kanyang balo na si Ella (Gabriela Silang) ang pakikipaglaban sa tulong ng isang matanda na si Tata Selo (halaw kay Melchora Aquino o Tandang Sora). At sa pangigipit ni Boss Tsip umusbong ang kagustuhan ng apat na bida na tumulong

sa pagsiwata ng virus at ganoon na rin ang pagtutol sa marahas na pamamalakad.

Si Kudz na isang muslim ang unang pinagdudahan at kinulong. Sa kabila ng pagsusumamo ni Andy na ipagpatuloy na ang rebelyon, hindi ito nagpatuloy dahil sa hindi pagsang-ayon ni Jayriz. Pinaglalaban ni Jayriz na kailangang itaguyod ang edukasyon upang magkaroon ng lakas ang lipunan na inaapi ng pamahalaan. At sa pagkamatay ni Pol dahil sa isang karamdaman, naglakas loob si Jayriz na tumakas sa lockdown at magtungo sa ibang bansa para ipagpatuloy ang edukasyon. At sa pag-aaral ni Jayriz at sa pagtatapos bilang isang ganap na mediko, natuklasan niya na isang gawa-gawang virus pala ang kumakalat sa kanyang bayan. Natuklasan din niya ang tamang gamutan upang masiwata ang virus.

Sa pagbabalik ni Jayriz at pagdadala ng lunas sa karamdaman, binaliktad pa siya ng pamahalaan ni Boss Tsip at pinaratangan pa ng rebelyon <mark>at sedisyon. Sa isa</mark>ng pekeng paglilitis, hinatulan si Jayriz ng kamatayan at siya ay binaril sa plaza. Ito ang nagtulak para kay Andy na ipaglaban ang Kalayaan kasama ang mga uring manggagawa na mga kasamahan siya. Sa pagtatagumpay ni Andy laban sa marahas na si Boss Tsip, napatunayan na maaabot ng bayan ang inaasam kung mayroong

pagkakaisa at malinis na hangarin na ipagtanggol at mahalin ang bayan.

Ang dulang musikal na ito ay malikhain at artistikong interpretasyon sa mahalagang kasaysayan ng Pilipinas upang maging mas malapit sa wika, gawi, musika, galaw, at kasuotan ng makabagong panahon.
