**ADMINISTRATION OF THE NATIONAL LEARNING CAMP
ASSESSMENT (NLCA) 2024**

1. In reference to Memorandum DM-CT-2024-040, titled Administration of the National Learning Camp Assessment (NLCA) 2024, the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) will conduct the National Learning Camp Assessment (NLCA) for Grades 7 to 10 public school learners to determine the effectiveness of the learning camp intervention on the learning proficiencies of participating learners before and after attending the National Learning Camp.
2. The assessment will be computer-based and shall cover learning areas in English, Science, and Mathematics. Each test item will measure varying levels of skills and competencies in a multiple-choice format using the English language.
3. The NLCA shall be administered on the following dates:

Grade Level	Activity	Testing Window
7 and 8	Pre-test	March 11 – April 12, 2024
9 and 10		April 15 – May 17, 2024

4. All enrolled Grades 7 to 10 learners from all public schools should activate/access their Moodle LMS accounts using their official DepEd Microsoft accounts for the conduct of the NLCA. School Testing and Division ITO should ensure that the learners have access to their DepEd Microsoft account and have accessed the DepEd LMS platform before the test administration.
5. In line with this, the preparations and guidelines that need to be considered for the administration will be discussed in an orientation scheduled on March 7, 2024 (Thursday) at 2:00 PM through a Microsoft Teams Platform Link to be informed through the School Testing Coordinators.
6. Participants of the orientation are the Public Secondary School Heads, School Testing Coordinators, and the School ICT Coordinators.



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7. All teaching personnel who render services during the preparation and conduct of this activity which may fall on weekends, holidays or special non-working days are entitled to service credits as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, re: Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers. On the other hand, non-teaching personnel shall be provided Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service rendered.
