DIVISION MEMORANDUM No. 341 s. 2024

Consultative Meeting and Planning on the Establishment of IPED Rural Farm School

TO: Assistant Schools Division Superintendents CID Chief Education Program Supervisor Education Program Supervisor In-Charge of ADM Public Schools District Supervisors School ADM Coordinators

- 1. The Enhanced Basic Education Program, as stipulated in Republic Act No. 10533 and the IPED provision of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (Sec. 8.4), mandates DepEd to develop a curriculum that is culture-sensitive, contextualized and flexible enough to enable and allow schools to localize and indigenize based on the social context of indigenous cultural communities (ICCs). Moreover, Republic Act No. 10618 is an act establishing rural farm school (RFS) as alternative delivery mode (ADM) of secondary education, and aims to provide quality education and promote sustainable agricultural productivity in the Philippines.
- 2. In support of this mandate, DepEd Division of Pampanga, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct Consultative Meeting and Planning on Indigenous Peoples Education (IPED) Rural Farm School (RFS) scheduled on June 26-28, 2024 at a venue to be announced later.
- 3. At the end of the activity participants are expected to develop a plan on contextualizing the curriculum for the IPED Program through the establishment of Rural Farm School interfacing the indigenous, knowledge, systems, and practices (IKSPs) of identified indigenous cultural communities (ICCs). Furthermore, this activity is part of community engagement in securing free, prior, informed, consent (FPIC) from the concerned ICCs.
- 4. Participants to this consultative meeting and planning are the Regional IPED Focal Person, Division IPED Focal Person and Alternate Focal Person, IP culture-


