1. The Brigada Eskwela is a national program of the Department of Education, also known as the National Schools Maintenance Week, which underscores the importance of cooperation between the school and the community. During the Brigada Eskwela Kick-off in 2022, Vice President and Education Secretary Sara Z. Duterte said, "The collaboration between the parents, the teachers, local governments, and the entire community on Brigada Eskwela opens a deeper and meaningful collaboration." Indeed, through this program, strong partnership with stakeholders is developed because it highlights the collective efforts from various partnership engagements, to achieve a safe learning environment while ensuring the delivery of quality education.

2. In accordance with Section 2 of RA 8525, it is the objective of the State to offer the Filipino learners with a quality and relevant education and to promote private initiative to support public education. To this purpose, the State shall implement programs to encourage private businesses and enterprises to aid in attaining quality learning in public schools across the nation. Adopt-a-School Program was established to allow private entities to assist public schools.

3. In lieu of the above, the Social Mobilization and Networking Section under the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) will conduct the "2024 Partnership Learning Session and Brigada Eskwela Orientation" on July 04, 2024 8:30 AM-3:00 PM at the Pavilion, Otel Pampanga, Lazatin Boulevard, City of San Fernando, Pampanga.

4. The objectives of the activity are:

- To enhance the skills of the participants in building partnerships;
- To strengthen partnership engagement for resource mobilization;
- To orient newly designated ASP & BE coordinators;
- To provide information on Brigada Eskwela implementation; and
