6. Mechanics of the Search

- a. The Division Search for Best EGPP school implementer is open to all public elementary and secondary schools, ether the school is recipient or non-recipient of GPP financial assistance from DepEd or partnered NGAs or NGOs.
- b. The Division Search is composed of two categories:
 - i. Division Best EGPP-Project GAME School Implementer (Elementary)
 - ii. Division Best EGPP-Project GAME School Implementer (Secondary)
- c. Sectors and Cluster can create search committee and innovate, contextualize and/or adapt the mechanics of the Regional Search.



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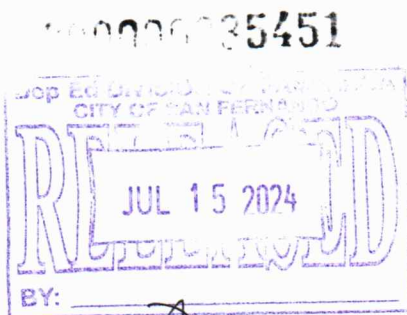


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- d. The Elementary Sectoral Search Committee should be chaired by the sectoral manager (PSDS) and School Health Section Nurse in charged per district as sole member.
 - e. The Secondary Cluster Search Committee should be chaired by the PSDS and School Health Section Nurse in charged per district as sole member.
 - f. Each Sector and Cluster shall submit one (1) entry on or before October 1, 2024. Late submission list of entries shall not be accepted.
 - g. Means of verification (MOVs) as indicated in the Regional Criteria must be presented during the onsite validation to the Division Search Committee, otherwise no points shall be given. The Division Search will follow the criteria indicated in the Regional Search as per RM No.451, s. 2024. *See Annex A.*
 - h. School with highest garnered scores shall be declared as Best Enhanced Gulayan sa Paaralan Program (EGPP)-Project GAME Division Winner in each category and will represent SDO Pampanga to the Regional Search.
 - i. Results on the selection and evaluation of the Division Selection Committee is final and irrevocable.

b. The Search is composed of two categories.

1. Best EGPP-Project GAME School Implementer in Elementary
2. Best EGPP-Project GAME School Implementer in Secondary

c. Each SDO shall submit one (1) entry per category using the attached template on or before October 31, 2024 through this link: <https://tinyurl.com/2024EGPPofficialentry>. Late submission of list of entries shall not be accepted.

d. Means of verification (MOVs) as indicated in the criteria must be presented during the onsite validation to the Regional Search Committee, otherwise no points shall be given. The criteria for Search are attached in this Memorandum.

e. During the onsite validation, school is requested to prepare and present the 2023 Gulayan sa Paraalan Program accomplishment report to the RSC.

f. School with highest garnered scores shall be declared as Best Enhanced Gulayan sa Paaralan (EGPP)-Project GAME Regional Winner in each category.

7. Winners shall receive the following prizes and non-winning nominees shall receive a certificate of recognition as finalist.




