As the Girl Scouts of the Philippines begins the new triennium, the **Girl Scout Week Celebration** scheduled on **September 15-21, 2024**, adopts the theme of the 26th National Council Convention, *“Women of Today for the Girls of Tomorrow”*. DATE	ACTIVITY
September 15, 2024	FAITH DAY <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Participate actively in a worship service such as Holy Mass, prayer meetings, praise and thanksgiving, sabbath etc. Share/post a personal prayer or Bible verse and caption it with personal reflection.
September 16, 2024	GIRLS’ DAY <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hold activities (Got talent, Runways etc) that will develop girls’ self-esteem, body confidence, skills, character and creativity.





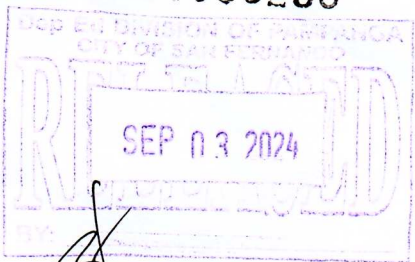
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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Share/post picture of the GS Activity and caption it on how it helped you develop your self-confidence and skills
September 17, 2024	<p>TROOP LEADERS' DAY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hold a recognition ceremony for the active troop leaders or created a traditional or digital artwork and post it in your social media account and send appreciation direct message to your Troop Leader or make an appreciation social media post about their impact to your life.
September 18, 2024	<p>ENVIRONMENT DAY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Join a community activity like coastal clean-up, tree planting, beautification of an area, vegetable gardening. Practice the 3 R's (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle)
September 19, 2024	<p>COMMUNITY/PARTNERSHIP DAY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have a story telling section about the life of Josefa Llanes Escoda with daycare students or conduct a zumba dance class for mothers/senior citizens in your barangay.
September 20, 2024	<p>ESCODA DAY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hold Escoda Ceremony and contribute to the JLE memento Fund. Learn about the life of Josefa Llanes Escoda and GSP Historical Milestones.
September 21, 2024	<p>FAMILY DAY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Spend quality time with your family by eating, playing, praying, cooking together or any other fun activities to foster good family relations.
