Bedroll/sleeping bags	Individual water tumblers




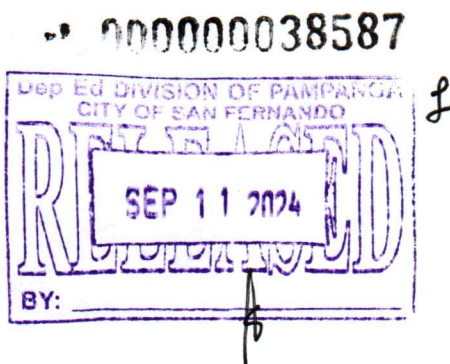
