CONDUCT OF DIVISION-WIDE SEMINAR WORKSHOP FOR TEACHER-RESEARCHERS

1. The Schools Division of Pampanga continues to elevate its efforts toward cultivating a research-driven environment aimed at advancing the quality of education. This progress is highlighted by the increasing number of research outputs submitted to the Schools Division Research Committee, reaffirming the crucial role of research in improving the quality of teaching. However, the focus remains on improving the quality of these research outputs to ensure continuous development in educational practices.
2. In line with this goal, the Schools Division of Pampanga, through the Schools Governance and Operations Division-Planning & Research Unit, hereby announces the conduct of a needs-based Seminar-Workshop for Teachers, which will take place on October 11, 18 & 30, 2024, at the Otel Pampanga, Skye Plaza Building, Lazatin Boulevard, City of San Fernando, Pampanga. The seminar-workshop will run from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
3. The seminar-workshop is specifically designed to address the research competency gaps identified by the Schools Division Research Committee through its Annual Needs-Based Assessment. These gaps were revealed through an analysis of data from action research studies proposed by teachers during Fiscal Year 2023 until the 3rd quarter of 2024. The sessions will be facilitated by a highly esteemed resource speaker, renowned for her expertise in research and statistics. The workshop aims to strengthen teachers' research skills to enhance their teaching strategies and interventions effectively.

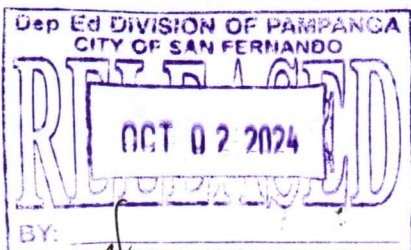
