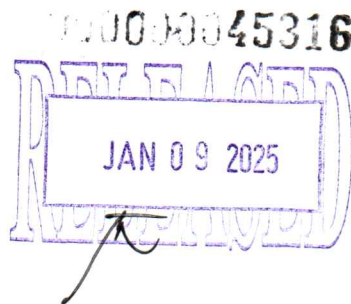

RR ENTERTAINMENT PRODUCTION

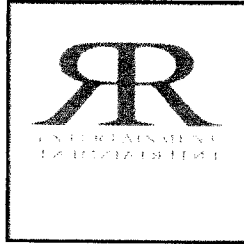
