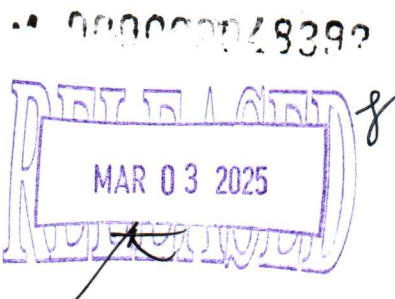
**FORUM CONSULTATION ON WOMEN IN THE PUBLIC SECTOR AND THE


To help cover the costs of snacks, documents, and other incidental expenses, we kindly request a minimal voluntary contribution of P100 from each participant.
