

ACTIVITIES


- Content Screening – Viewing of the film YOLO, emphasizing themes such as mental health, bullying, empathy, and positive peer relationships.

We believe this event will be a valuable opportunity for today's learners to enhance their self-awareness, empathy, communication, and advocacy skills in a creative and meaningful way.






