2. Background and Purpose. The Basic Training Course for Unit Leaders is a 3-day live-in training of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines designed to equip Unit Leaders with the knowledge and skills needed to effectively work with both young people and other Adults in Scouting in terms of youth program delivery. With the revised BSP Unit Leader's Training Scheme, Unit Leader Training Courses aim to develop the following among Unit Leaders:



- a. An understanding of the historical background, fundamental principles, organizational structures, and spirit of Scouting; and
- b. An understanding of the needs of young people within the specific environment in which the leader and young people will be working:
 - The ability to use the Scout Method and the skills of Scouting to meet the needs and aspirations of young people adapted to various age groups for the KID, KAB, Boy, Senior, and Rover Scouting sections;
 - The ability to apply the team system and enabling youth involvement and youth empowerment through learning by doing and symbolic framework;
 - The personal leadership skills to work positively and constructively with young people and other adults; and
 - The personal management skills to plan for, implement, administer, and evaluate the Sectional Youth Program that will contribute to the personal growth of young people to play a constructive role in the society.
- 3. Participants. The general qualifications for the participants are as follows:
 - a. Must be currently registered
 - b. Must be currently handling a Unit as Unit Leaders or Assistant Unit Leaders
 - c. Must be physically fit as certified by a licensed physician
 - d. Must be of good moral character
- 4. Training Fee. The Training Fee shall cover the administrative and operational expenses which include but are not limited to training materials, meals and snacks (starting AM snack of first day until lunch of last day of training), and utilities. Payment of the Training Fee should be settled on or before the said deadline and ON-SITE REGISTRATION IS NOT ALLOWED. The Training Fee is NON-REFUNDABLE but transferable.

The training fee can be charged against School's Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) or other available school/local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
