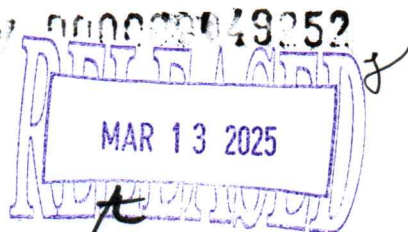

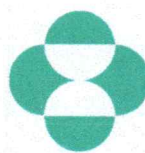
**EMPOWERING WOMEN: CERVICAL CANCER AWARENESS CAMPAIGN FOR
