**LIST OF SCHOOLS IMPLEMENTING THE 2025 DEPARTMENT OF
EDUCATION SUMMER PROGRAMS**

1. In support of the Department's commitment to address learning loss and close the learning gaps reflected in national and international large-scale assessment and as mandated through DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2025, the Schools Division of Pampanga releases the list of schools which will offer summer programs to prepare learners for school year 2025-2026.
2. Specifically, the unique summer programs lodged under **Project Support Programs in Arithmetic and Reading for Kapampangan Learners (SPARKLE)** shall include:
 - a. Summer Program for Key Stage 1
 - 1) Literacy Remediation for Grade 3
 - 2) Mathematics remediation Program for Grade 3
 - b. Summer Programs for Key Stages 2-4
 - 1) Summer Academic Remedial Program for Grades 4-12
3. These strategic intervention programs aim to bridge critical gaps between learners' current performance and grade-level expectations which are predicated on the understanding that unmastered learning standards and competencies create significant barriers to future academic success. These interventions provide support and strengthen learners' foundational knowledge and skills vital to their success as they move forward to their education journey. Through these, DepEd aims to reinforce key concepts and skills and empower the learners to enter the next school year with confidence and readiness for the new challenges.
4. Attached is the list of schools which will implement summer remediation programs suited to their context and purpose.

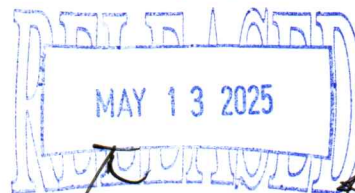


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5. The four-week summer remediation programs shall commence on May 13, 2025, and shall end on June 6, 2025.
6. Implementing schools are strongly advised to observe all guidelines set under DO No. 10, s. 2025 to ensure maximum success of the summer programs.
7. All teacher-volunteers shall be entitled of service credits as stipulated in the DO 13, s. 2024 – Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers. Likewise, they shall receive certificates of appreciation and other incentives subject to the availability of funds and applicable guidelines.
8. Further, all implementing schools shall be required to submit the necessary reports to the Central, Regional, and School Division Offices for proper documentation.
9. Meanwhile, EPSs, PSDSs, SGOD-Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) and Human Resource Development (HRD) & E shall conduct the monitoring of the summer programs and shall provide appropriate technical assistance where necessary using the attached LRP Monitoring Tool. The list of monitoring team shall be released in a separate memorandum.
10. Wide dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is earnestly desired.
