5. This memorandum shall serve as the **Travel Authority** of the identified participants.

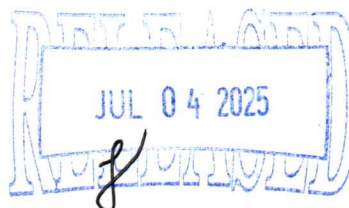
