1. Pursuant to the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013 (RA 10533), this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), announces the conduct of an **Online Division Training on the Development of Interactive, Contextualized, Localized, and Indigenized Teaching and Learning Materials in Science (Phase 2- Validation of the IMs)** on October 29-30, 2025, from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. via Microsoft Teams.
2. The division seminar aims to:
 - 2.1 relate the curriculum to a particular setting, situation, or area of application to make the competencies relevant, meaningful, and useful to learners;
 - 2.2. help teachers to guide learners to grasp complex scientific ideas more easily; and
 - 2.3. encourage science teachers to develop instructional materials in science that will encourage learners to analyze and interpret scientific information within their local context.
3. The participants in this activity are 70 Science teachers and 8 members of the Quality Assurance Committee and are advised to ensure stable internet connectivity and prepare the necessary digital tools for full engagement in the virtual sessions. Teachers are strongly encouraged to participate with full attention and focus, minimizing distractions and treating the training with the same level of professionalism as face-to-face engagements.
4. School heads of the participants are advised to assign relieving teachers to maximize time-on-task stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
5. The MS Teams link will be sent through the official group chat and email of the participants before the scheduled meeting.



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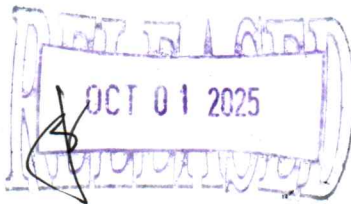
