

- 2. **Aim and Objectives.** Tree planting activities fosters environmental stewardship and community responsibility by planting trees that serve as a living legacy for future generations, promoting sustainability, ecological balance, and a greener future. This activity aims to:
  - a. To raise awareness on the importance of trees in combating climate change, conserving biodiversity, and maintaining ecological balance.
  - b. To encourage community participation in environmental protection by engaging Scouts, Scouts Leaders, volunteers, partners, and community members in tree planting.
  - c. To create a healthier and greener environment that will benefit present and future generations.
  - d. To instill values of responsibility, care, and stewardship toward nature, ensuring that the planted trees are nurtured and sustained.
- 3. Personal Provisions. Participants should bring the following:
  - a. Attire: Neckerchief and outdoor attire with sun protective gears
  - b. Tumblers and drinking water
  - c. Snacks and refreshments
  - d. Personal medications
  - e. Cleaning materials and trash bags
- 4. All duly registered Scout and Scout Leaders are welcome to join this activity, subject to strict adherence to the BSP Safeguarding Policy. Scout Leaders are required to secure the Scouting Event Waiver and Parental Consent Form of their Scouts. For Scouts, STRICTLY NO PARENTAL CONSENT, NO PARTICIPATION.
- 5. Participants of public and private schools shall be subject to the no-disruption of classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 titled "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith."



- 6. Furthermore, Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) for public non-teaching personnel and Service Credits for public teaching personnel will be granted in lieu of the days that will fall on weekends and holidays in accordance with the DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2004 titled "Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2015, titled "Policies and Guidelines on Overtime Services and Overtime Pay for Government Employees."
