OBSERVANCE OF THE 2025 GLOBAL HANDWASHING DAY CELEBRATION WITH THE THEME "BE A HANDWASHING HERO!"

- 1. Pursuant to OUOPS Memorandum dated October 6, 2025 issued by the Office of the Undersecretary for Governance and Operations, through the Bureau of Learner Support Services School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), and in collaboration with the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), the Department of Education enjoins all field offices and schools to participate in the 2025 Global Handwashing Day celebration with the theme "Be a Handwashing Hero!".
- The Global Handwashing Day is commemorated every 15th day of October to increase awareness and understanding on the importance of proper handwashing with soap as an effective and affordable means to prevent diseases and save lives.
- 3. In observance of this celebration, a virtual program will be streamed via the official DepEd Philippines Facebook Page on October 15, 2025 (Wednesday), from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. The activity will highlight best practices from DepEd regions implementing the Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS) Program and promote a strong culture of hand hygiene among learners and personnel.
- 4. All schools are enjoined to participate virtually in the said activity. Division and School WinS Coordinators are further encouraged to organize school-based advocacy activities such as:
 - Demonstration of proper handwashing techniques;
 - o Posting of hand hygiene information materials; and
 - o Commitment campaigns using the slogan "Be a Handwashing Hero!"

This global advocacy is celebrated every 15th day of October and is dedicated to increasing awareness and understanding on the importance of handwashing with soap as an effective and affordable way to prevent diseases and save lives.

This activity aims to showcase the best practices of DepEd regions visited during the series of validation activities for the Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS) Program and in promoting a hand hygiene culture among the learners that emphasizes handwashing as a critical public health measure to safe school the aforementioned DepEd regions designed for both elementary and secondary learners that demonstrate the importance of clean surroundings and hygienic practices such as, but not limited to, proper handwashing. Further, the importance of using nudges in reinforcing handwashing habits among learners as an important public health strategy shall be emphasized.

Annex B

Guidelines for recording the required video presentation of each region

1. The video presentation to be submitted by each region should highlight their commitment to supporting this year's theme of Global Handwashing Day. Recommended spiel is as follows:

"Here at DepEd Region _____, we proudly commit to being Handwashing Heroes For-The-WinS"

- 2. The duration of the video presentation must be 15 seconds to 30 seconds (must not exceed 30 seconds);
- 3. The following procedures are recommended when recording a video:
 - Subject must be positioned at the center of the frame;
 - b. Medium Shot (from the top of their head to roughly their waist) is recommended:
 - Give at least an inch for the head room for the subject;
 - d. Set audio recording to Stereo;
 - e. Choose a good background, face the window instead and use it as a source of light;
 - f. Illuminate your face using a ring light or any source of light;
- 4. Video format should be MP4 with 1080p or 720p resolution;
- 5. Recommended minimum specifications for videos:
 - a. File Format: MP4
 - b. Dimensions: 1920px x 1080px (16:9)
 - c. Orientation: Landscape
 - d. Frame Rate: 30fps
