In line with the celebration of the 36th National Statistics Month, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Pampanga Provincial Statistical Office, in partnership with the Schools Division of Pampanga, will conduct various activities. One of these activities is the **On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest** which will be held on October 27, 2025, at 9:00 AM at the PSA Pampanga Provincial Statistical Office, City of San Fernando, Pampanga.
2. The theme for this year is **"Accelerating the SDG Pace of Progress: Mobilizing Data for All."**
3. Each municipality in Pampanga shall be represented by one currently enrolled Junior High School learner.

Mechanics**

1. Each city/municipality shall be represented by one contestant who is a junior high school student currently enrolled this school year 2025-2026.
2. The contestant shall register using the link (<https://tinyurl.com/vftn3w>) until 24 October 2025 | 3:00 PM.
3. Only the following materials to be provided by PSA will be used during the contest:
 - a. One-Fourth illustration board
 - b. Lead pencil, eraser, black marker, tissue, yellow pad paper, ruler and ball pen
 - c. Oil pastel (25 colors)
4. The entries must be drawn impromptu by the contestants at PSA Provincial Statistical Office.
5. Entries must be completed within 2 hours.
6. The poster design should be in harmony with this year's theme "**Accelerating the SDG Pace of Progress: Mobilizing Data for All**"
7. The finished entries will be displayed at PSA Pampanga Provincial Statistical Office for judging.
8. Each entry will be judged based on the following criteria:

CRITERIA	PERCENTAGE
Relevance to the theme	50%
Creativity and Visual Impact	30%
Completeness	20%

9. The decision of the board of judges shall be final.
10. The declared champion, 1st Runner-up and Second Runner-up will received a plaque of appreciation and a medal.
11. All winning and non-winning entries shall become property of the PSA.
