1. The Schools Division Office of Pampanga, in partnership with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines – Pampanga Council, announces the conduct of the KID and KAB Olympics on December 6, 2025, 8:00AM to 5:00PM at Casa Leonardo, Barangay San Juan, Mexico, Pampanga with the theme:

"One Earth, One Team: KID & KAB Scouts Moving for a Sustainable Future."

- 2. This activity aims to promote physical fitness, foster teamwork and cooperation, develop character and values, enhance scouting skills, strengthen leadership and confidence, and reinforce the spirit of scouting among KID and KAB Scouts.
- 3. All participants must be currently registered BSP KID and KAB Scouts. They are required to wear their scouting uniform, with a minimum requirement consisting of a neckerchief, white shirt, and carabao slide, and must present a parental consent before joining the activity.
- 4. Teacher-participants who will supervise or accompany the scouts shall be granted **one** (1) **day Service Credit** pursuant to **DepEd Order No.** 53, s. 2003. To facilitate the granting of service credits, all teachers are required to **encode their names through this link:** <a href="https://shorturl.at/jgxb8">https://shorturl.at/jgxb8</a>. The link will close on **December 3, 2025**. Teachers who fail to encode their names on or before the deadline **will not be eligible** to request service credit.

- 1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines Pampanga Council is pleased to announce the conduct of the KID & KAB OLYMPICS with the theme "One Earth, One Team: KID & KAB Scouts Moving for a Sustainable Future" this 6 December 2025 at Casa Leonardo, San Juan, Mexico, Pampanga.
- 2. Purpose and Objectives. The KAB Olympics aims to promote the holistic development of KAB Scouts through fun, friendly, and values-oriented physical and mental activities. It serves as a venue for young Scouts to demonstrate teamwork, sportsmanship, discipline, and the spirit of fair play while strengthening their sense of belonging and pride in the Scouting Movement.
  - a. Promote Physical Fitness Encourage KAB Scouts to engage in active play and sports to develop strength, coordination, and healthy habits.
  - b. Foster Teamwork and Cooperation Build camaraderie and unity among KAB Scouts by engaging them in group games and cooperative challenges.
  - c. Develop Character and Values Instill the ideals of the Scout Oath and Law—particularly honesty, fairness, respect, and discipline—through sports and friendly competition.
  - d. Enhance Scouting Skills Provide opportunities for Scouts to apply basic Scouting knowledge, creativity, and problem-solving abilities in varied activities.
  - e. Promote Leadership and Confidence Encourage KAB Scouts to take initiative, show leadership, and build self-confidence in a supportive and fun environment.
  - Strengthen Scouting Spirit Reinforce pride in being a Scout and foster fellowship among members, leaders, parents, and the community through a meaningful Scouting event.
- Participation. This event is open to ALL KID and KAB Scouts who:
  - a. Must be currently registered to BSP through Pampanga Council;
  - b. Must have Scouting uniform with a minimum requirement of neckerchief and
  - c. Must be physically fit as certified by a licensed physician; and
  - d. Must be accompanied by their parents or legal guardians.
- 4. Registration. A registration fee of Php 200.00 per Scout shall be charged to defray all operating and administrative expenses which include but may not be limited to

program materials, IDs, certificates, and rental fees of the venue. Parents, Langkay Leaders, and Kawan Leaders are free of charge.

- 5. Payment. The deadline of payment is on 28 November 2025. To ensure efficient transactions, payment of registration of all participants shall be done in bulk and only District BSP Coordinators or assigned representatives per District are allowed to process the payments. District BSP Coordinators or assigned representatives per District are requested to facilitate the collection of registration fees of all their participants prior to payment to the BSP Pampanga Council.
- 6. Personal Provisions. Participants are advised to bring the following:
  - a. Packed Lunch and Snacks
  - b. Water and Water Canisters
  - c. Extra Clothes (for Water Fun)
  - d. Personal medicine (if any)
- 7. All concerned Scout Leaders, Institutional Heads, and District Coordinators are enjoined to actively support, endorse, and encourage the participation of KAB Scouts in this meaningful Scouting activity. Active participation in the KAB Olympics will not only provide opportunities for fun and learning but also foster camaraderie, leadership, and the spirit of fair play among KAB Scouts. All District Scouting Committees and Schools are therefore urged to extend their utmost cooperation to ensure the successful conduct of this event.
