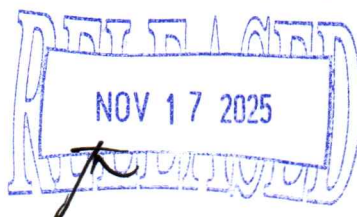
**AMENDMENT TO DM NO. 707, S. 2025, RE: DIVISION TRAINING ON THE
