

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Information and Communications Technology Service (ICTS), in partnership with Google for Education, invites selected DepEd personnel to join the Project SINAG Orientation Sessions – a briefing series highlighting enhancements to Google Workspace for Education Plus, the integration of AI tools such as Gemini and Notebook LM, and the latest features of Google Classroom.
2. These sessions will start on **24 October 2025** and will be held in strategic locations across the country, including an online session to ensure inclusive participation.
3. **Concept**
 - 3.1. Project SINAG – short for *Supercharging Instruction for National Advancement with Google* – is more than a training program; it is a movement to empower DepEd personnel to become catalysts of digital transformation. The initiative aims to:
 - 3.1.1. Enhance the skills and technical knowledge of participants in using Google Workspace for Education Plus, Google AI tools (e.g., Gemini, Notebook LM).
 - 3.1.2. Improve workplace practices with Google Classroom's new features for collaboration and workflow optimization.
 - 3.1.3. Mentor colleagues and facilitate the cascading of acquired knowledge across schools and offices.

3.2. Expected outputs

- 3.2.1. Increased proficiency to use Google Workspace Plus and Google AI tools in pedagogy, administrative work, and school leadership.
- 3.2.2. Expanded pool of SINAG Champions who actively mentor and support colleagues at the regional and division levels.
- 3.2.3. Collection of AI-enhanced and collaborative outputs.
- 3.2.4. Region/Division plans for post-event mentoring and ripple training to ensure sustained impact.


