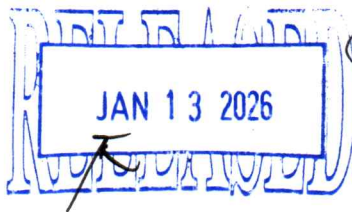

### Objectives

Through artistic creation, the competition encourages environmental responsibility from an early age, raises public awareness of environmental issues, and fosters children's aesthetic and creative education.

1. **Participants: Age Range:** 3–15 years old

**Children's Division:** Ages 3–9

**Junior / Teens Division:** Ages 10–15



## 2. Theme of the Competition:

### Children's Paintings of the Climate Future

The theme “**Children Painting Our Future Climate**” invites children from around the world to reflect on the shared challenges posed by climate change.

Using imagination as their brush and hope for the future as their inspiration, participants are encouraged to create artworks that present a **hopeful, reflective, and solution-oriented vision** for the planet's climate future. This theme seeks to convey the concept of **harmonious coexistence between humanity and nature**, inspire environmental awareness, and encourage collective action to protect our shared home—the Earth.

## 3. Entry Requirements:

3.1 All submissions must be **original artworks**. Works that have been previously published or submitted to other competitions are not eligible.

3.2 For submission details, please refer to the **Submission Instructions**. The copyright and ownership of submitted works shall belong to the **Organizing Committee**

3.3 Only **painting artworks** are accepted. There are no restrictions on style or medium.

- Maximum size: approximately **54 × 38 cm**
- Smaller paper sizes (approximately **half of 54 × 38 cm**) are also acceptable
- For traditional Chinese paintings, the size must not exceed a **four-foot square**
- **Do not frame or mount** the artwork

3.4 Artistic style is unrestricted. Entries should align with the competition theme and demonstrate imagination, observation, creativity, and expressive ability.

3.5 Each participant may submit **only one (1) artwork**

## 4. Submission Instructions:

Please submit the **original artwork** together with the **fully completed Registration Form**, securely attached to the **back of the artwork**. Do not frame the artwork or mount it on hard board.

## Awards & Rewards

### Rewards for Overseas Winners

- **Grand Prize**

The winning child and **one guardian** will be invited to attend the award ceremony. The organizers will cover **round-trip travel, accommodation, and meals** for both the winner and one guardian during the event.

The winner will receive an **award certificate** and a **collection of winning artworks**

- **First Prize**

The winning child will be invited to attend the award ceremony. The organizers will cover the **travel, accommodation, and meals** for the winner, as well as **accommodation and meals** for one guardian (guardian’s travel expenses are self-funded).

The winner will receive an **award certificate** and a **collection of winning artworks**

- **Second Prize**

The winning child will receive a **bursary of RMB 2,000 (tax included)** and an invitation to the award ceremony. All travel, accommodation, and meal expenses will be **self-funded**

An **award certificate** and **collection of winning artworks** will be presented.

- **Third Prize**

The winning child will receive a **bursary of RMB 1,000 (tax included)**, along with an **award certificate** and **collection of winning artworks**

Attendance at the award ceremony is optional, with all expenses self-funded.

- **Merit Award**

An **award certificate** will be presented. Attendance at the award ceremony is optional, with all expenses self-funded.

- **Organization Award**

Each award-winning organization may send **one representative** to attend the award ceremony. The organizers will cover **travel, accommodation, and meals**

## Exhibition and Publication

All winning artworks may be selected for inclusion in the **electronic art book**

*“Children Painting Our Future Climate – The 9th International Children’s Environmental Conservation Painting Competition.”*

Artworks awarded **Third Prize and above** will be included in the **printed collection** of the same title.

## Special Statement

The Organizing Committee will issue award notifications to the parents or guardians of **Grand Prize, First Prize, and Second Prize** winners. The notification receipt must be completed and returned **within seven (7) days** of receipt; otherwise, the award will be deemed forfeited.

Winners of the Grand Prize, First Prize, or Second Prize who are unable to attend the award ceremony for personal reasons will be considered to have **forfeited the award**, and will receive only the **award certificate and artwork collection**. Awards are **non-transferable**



The copyright of all submitted artworks belongs to the organizers, while the artists retain the right of authorship. The organizers reserve the right to retain and use the works for related activities, including but not limited to exhibitions, media coverage, websites, posters, and publications. The organizers also reserve the right to dispose of the artworks for **public welfare fundraising purposes**, such as charity auctions. No additional remuneration will be provided.

This competition is a **non-profit public welfare initiative** dedicated to environmental protection. **No participation fees** will be charged.
