- Supporting documents to substantiate the nominee's contributions, achievements, or notable service
- Certification of registration with the BSP for a minimum of **two (2) years**





SUBJECT : **CALL FOR NOMINATION FOR
THE BSP NATIONAL LOWER AWARDS**

1. In line with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines' commitment to recognize exemplary service, leadership, and outstanding contributions to the Scouting Movement, this Council is hereby calling for nominations for the **BSP National Lower Awards**.
2. **Background.** The BSP National Lower Awards are conferred upon deserving Scouters, officials, institutions, and supporters who have demonstrated commendable dedication and service in advancing the aims and objectives of Scouting at the unit, district, council, and community levels.
3. **Awards and General Qualifications.** Nominations may be submitted for qualified individuals or institutions for the following BSP National Lower Awards (as applicable):
 - A. **SERVICE AWARD**
For registered Scout Leaders of all categories for their devoted services in the Units, Institutions and District/Municipal Scouting Committees:
 - a. **Quota (for Bronze):** 20% of the total number of registered unit leaders and assistants
 - b. **Interval:** Every 2 years of continued membership and service
 - B. **MEDAL OF MERIT**
For registered Scout Leaders and Lay Leaders of all categories for noteworthy services and/or accomplishments in connection with Scouting activities/projects that contributed to the promotion of the Scouting Movement, the enrichment of the Scouting program and/or enhancement of the prestige of BSP:
 - a. **Quota (for Bronze):** 20% of the total number of registered unit leaders and assistants
 - b. **Interval:** Every 2 years of continued membership and service

4. **Nomination Requirements.** All nominations must be forwarded to respective District Scouting Committees through District Scout Commissioners and District BSP Coordinators for consolidation and endorsement, which includes
 - a. Name of the Recommandee
 - b. Current date of registration
 - c. Position in Scouting
 - d. Last Award Received and Year of Award
 - e. Specific Achievements
5. **Deadline of Submission.** District Scouting Committees shall forward the duly accomplished and fully signed Consolidated Nomination Forms (<https://bit.ly/BSP-AIS-LowerAwards-Form>) to the Council on or before **30 January**

2026, 12:00 PM for submission to the National Office. **Incomplete and late submissions shall not be processed.**

6. All concerned are enjoined to give this memorandum the widest dissemination and to actively participate in recognizing deserving individuals who exemplify the true spirit of Scouting.
