**LEARNER GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS AND APPOINTMENTS
FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2026-2027**

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 12, s. 2026 titled "*Learner Government (LG) Elections for School Year (S.Y.) 2026-2027*," this Office, through the School Governance and Operations Division – Learner Formation Unit, announces the schedule of elections and appointments for the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) for School Year 2026-2027.
2. The indicative timeline of activities shall be observed:

Activity	Suggested Dates
Establishment of the LG COMEA	January 26-30, 2026
Application Period, Screening Process, Posting of Candidates, and Campaign Period	February 2-13, 2026
School-based Elections/Appointment Process	February 16-20, 2026
District/Cluster Elections	February 23-27, 2026
Division Elections	Within March 2-6, 2026 (to be announced in a separate Memorandum)

3. The School Head shall endorse a qualified teacher for designation as the SELG/SSLG Teacher-Adviser to the Schools Division Office through the SGOD. In line with DepEd Order No. 5, s. 2024, the advisership shall be considered a teaching-related assignment, in addition to the ancillary duties of teachers.
4. A virtual orientation on the conduct of elections will be held on **January 26, 2026**, at **2:00 PM** via Microsoft Teams (<https://tinyurl.com/pamp-lgp-orientation2627>). School Heads and SELG/SSLG Teacher-Advisers are expected to attend.

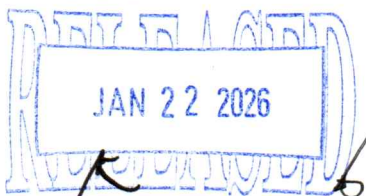

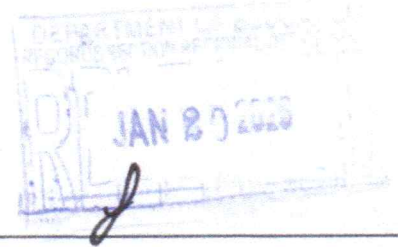

Anent to Department of Education Order No. 12, series of 2025, titled **"Multi-Year Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities,"** the Bureau of Learner Support Services–Youth Formation Division (BLSS–YFD), announces the **conduct of the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) Elections for School Year 2026–2027** in all public elementary and secondary schools.

The establishment and strengthening of the SELG and SSLG aim to develop leadership competencies, promote learner participation in school governance, and amplify learners' voices in decision-making.

3. All Division Youth Formation Coordinators (DYFCs) are requested to provide the necessary technical assistance and guidance to ensure the orderly, timely, and effective conduct of the elections. In addition, schools are advised to refer to the previous issued election guidelines for the proper guidance on the conduct of
