 - 2.4 integrate digital technologies in classroom instruction, assessment, and learner performance monitoring to promote active engagement and improve learning outcomes; and



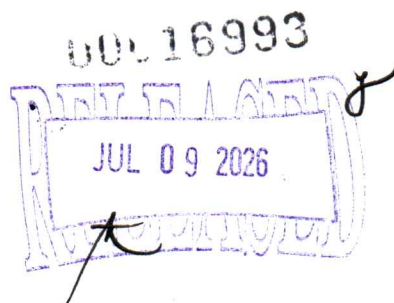
